LATE JUSTICE GOPALJI MEHROTRA



Late Justice Gopalji Mehrotra was the son of Smt. & Sri Radhe Mohan Mehrotra. He was born in 1904. He was very patriotic from an early age, was actively involved in the freedom struggle of the country and served time in prison on two occasions. He practiced law at Allahabad High Court, was elevated as a judge of the same Court in May 1954 and served there until October 1957. He was transferred to Assam in November 1957 and served as a Judge of the Gauhati High Court until June 1961, when he was appointed as the Chief Justice. He served as the Chief Justice of Assam & Nagaland until February 1967. Late Justice Gopalji Mehrotra left for his heavenly abode suddenly due to a heart condition on 10th September 1969.


S. S. Khanna Girls' Degree College, Prayagraj




